Dark Night FAQs

Q: What is the Dark Night Series?

A: On nights that Milk Can is not producing *Malfi Inc.*, we will be hosting our Dark Night Series. Comedy shows, improv shows, ten-minute plays, one-acts, new works – all are welcome at the Dark Nights!

Q: When are the performances?

A: Times vary, but dates are November 12-21, 2010. You cannot choose your date/time. It will be randomly assigned to you.

Q: Where are the performances?

A: At Theatre 54 (244 West 54th St., 12th floor).

Q: Who can apply?

A: Anybody with a show can apply! However, you are responsible for producing the show. We do not provide directors, actors, designers, stage managers, or rehearsal space.

Q: What do you provide?

A: We give you the performance space for free. We will advertise your show on our website and in our e-blast mailings. And your show will be featured in our print newsletter. We provide you a box office person and house manager on your performance day.

Q: Who keeps the ticket sale money?

A: The Milk Can Theatre Company keeps all ticket sale money.

Q: How much time do I get in the theatre?

A: You get access up to one hour before the show. (Though you must leave the stage clean and clear at least fifteen minutes prior to curtain so that the audience can enter.) If additional time in the theatre becomes available we will notify all Dark Night participants and divvy it up on a first come first served basis.

Q: Can I use AEA actors?

A: Absolutely! But you are responsible for all AEA paperwork and payment.

Q: Who provides programs?

A: You provide programs. When you arrive at the theatre you can leave them with the box office manager, who will distribute them.
